
BUILDING UPON A PROMISING FOUNDATION

The Vermont Futures Project has developed a robust dashboard of 100+ metrics that track Vermont's economic health. While compiling the data, there have been several research initiatives to explore topics such as workforce, housing, taxation, and young professional cost of living.

The Vermont Futures Project uses data to bring people from different perspectives together for productive discourse aligned towards common goals and values.
